WILD ROOIBOS

Cederberg Mountains, South Africa
Beyond organic, this Rooibos is harvested completely wild in its
indigenous habitat in the Cederberg Mountains. Deep earthy notes,
bright red berries, and cedar.

HIBISCUS FLOWERS

Satemwa Estate, Shire Highlands, Malawi
These whole hibiscus flowers produce a beautiful
raspberry red colour and the flavours of rich berries.
Slightly tart, with a cranberry sweet finish.

SPANISH FENNEL FLOWERS

Tarragona, Catalonia, Spain
Elegant and smooth with a unique sweetness and a bright aroma.
A vivacious anise flavour with notes of citrus.

Fanjing Mountain, Guizhou Province, China
Soft hay with notes of apricots and an elegant and lingering buttery finish.

GENMAICHA

Shizuoka, Japan

This Sencha is buttery and soft. Rich, verdant notes with a deep comforting aroma of popcorn.

MALAWI STEAMED GREEN

Satemwa Estate, Shire Highlands, Malawi

The flavour is succulent and extremely rich with high tannins.

Made entirely from the first tender leaf buds of Spring. Not flavoured, but carefully scented over six consecutive nights with fresh jasmine flowers.

Unprocessed and crafted entirely from tender spring buds. Picked for only five days of the year, just before the buds unfurl to the first new leaves.

MALAWI WHITE SILVER TIP

Savoury with a deep peachy note and precise tannins. Clean and fresh with a lovely minerality.
