



Hartsfield Manor was built in the 1860's by Arthur Woodriff Jaffray as a family home. Before the house was completed Arthur died in a shooting accident in 1864. He left a young widow Mary and their only daughter Lilian. There is a memorial for Arthur Jaffray at the west wall of St Michaels Church in Betchworth. The lych-gate at the entrance to the churchyard is also dedicated to him.

Carvings around the main entrance point to the estimated completion of Hartsfield Manor as 1869 and in 1871 Mary remarried to Captain James Moir. They had six children, three of whom remained in the village and were known by many Betchworth villagers. Mary Moir died in 1885 and Hartsfield was sold on to Mrs Higford, and then the Lloyd family.

In the Second World War the house was taken over by the Canadian Army and used as a hospital. After the war the house was run for a time as a hotel, and later, was bought by Midland Bank as a Staff Training College. Internally many changes were made and several buildings were added.

De Vere Venues owned Hartsfield Manor for some time and then it was sold again in 2016 to its current owner, the Manor Collection Group.
